In 2023 MECFA focused on three key activities; Education and training for CF teams, Donating diagnostics, and Lobbying for drug and care access. An emergency relief fund was established to aid CF patients in Turkey struck by devastating earthquakes. The Giving Breath Campaign donated 100 nebulizers to people with CF in Jordan and MECFA supported patient organizations in Jordan and Turkey.

ISTANBUL, TURKEY

5 DAY CF COURSE

November 20 to 24, 2023

Program participants will undergo basic training in the management of cystic fibrosis and setting up a CF Centre in their own countries. This programme will continue with online meetings between the participants and the Marmara University CF Centre. Participants will be divided into their background experience (physician, dietitian, nurse or physiotherapist) and additional education will be tailored according to this information.



Training will include



Lectures

Covering diagnosis, clinical characteristics of CF, management of CF, airway clearence techniques, nutritional approach, future treatment modalities including modulator therapies and genetics.



In patient/Out patient

Marmara is the largest CF center in Turkey following 450 pts. 50 CF pts will be seen at the outpatient clinic and 5 hospitalized pts will be followed and the approach to their problems will be discussed.




Practical

Covering bronchoscopy, sweat testing, spirometry and physiotherapy. Discussions on newborn screening, registry and quality improvement studies will be included. At the end of the week, the aim is to create a network among MECFA member countries to improve the standards of CF care in the region.
